#### Indiana Epsilon House Corporation Formed

As many of you know, the Indiana Epsilon House Corporation was formed and incorporated in 1985. Since that time, the House Corporation's Board of Directors (the "Board") has assumed an active role in Phi Kappa Psi at V.U.

The Board is charged with supervising house operations, offering advice to the Actives on a variety of subjects and providing a pool of knowledge regarding every aspect of the house--all while taking great care not to infringe upon the Active's right of self-determination. For example, the Board and the chapter have had dialogue which proved influential in the Chapter's excellent management of several difficult problems including the liability insurance crisis, liability risk control, alcohol control and pledge education in light of anti-hazing legislation. The Board has assumed responsibility for housing contracts--each year the Board reviews and revises the contracts, distributes them to parents, responds to parental questions and concerns regarding housing

and monitors compliance with contract terms. Further, the Board has undertaken to act as an Alumni-Active liaison, to publish a Newsletter and solicit Alumni donations.

In short, the Board makes meaningful contributions to the quality of Phi Psi life at V.U. and we really enjoy working with the Active Brothers. Each year we are increasingly impressed with the energy and maturity the Actives display, not to mention their perennial domination of academics, athletics and rush. We encourage all Alumni to get involved--through active participation (elections for the Corporation are held annually at Homecoming) and/or donations, which are channeled to the Actives. The House Corporation stands proud and strong as we strive to maintain the incredible success story of Phi Psi at V.U.
